**4. QJ&J BOAT**

It was **AGREED** that the QJ&J would be relocated to Rescue Wooden Boats in Stiffkey. It was **AGREED** that the Clerk would make enquiries into the cost of relocation. It was **AGREED** that the Clerk would discuss the required future maintenance of the QJ&J with Rescue Wooden Boats. It was **AGREED** that the Clerk and Peter Stibbons will meet with the Henry Blogg Museum to discuss future maintenance and the possibility of volunteers carrying out most if not all of the work required. It was **AGREED** to recommend to Full Council that the QJ&J be sited on the gangway behind the old Lifeboat House once it has been refurbished and the Clerk will liaise with North Norfolk District Council. It was **AGREED** that if North Norfolk District Council agree to the location a planning application will be submitted for the siting of the QJ&J. It was **AGREED** that Rosie Glasgow would submit the full Heritage Lottery application for funding of the refurbishment.
