7.1 The Chairman reported that the arrangements are going very well. The Clerk has circulated the Minutes of the last meeting.

8. <u>REPORTS FROM REPRESENTATIVES</u>

- 8.1 Chamber of Trade:- Sam Grout reported that the Norfolk Show was a great success. The Chamber of Trade has been split into working groups and one of the working groups is dealing with promotion of the town. It is hoped that they can work together with other organisations in Cromer to achieve the desired effect. The Chamber of Trade would like to find some spaces around town where information signage can be erected directing people around the town more effectively. There have been some complaints that the traders close at 4.00 pm which is not the case. The website is there for the traders to upload items of interest for the town. It was reported that Henry's has achieved 10,000 customers in the three months that they have been opened. Sam AGREED to email the Clerk the dates for the Chamber of Trade meetings in order that the Cromer Town Council representative can attend.

- **8.5 RNLI:-** Clir. Leeds reported that the RNLI have had their coastal review meeting. The date for this year's Lifeboat Day is Sunday 31st July. It was **AGREED** that the Cromer War Memorial, Christmas Events Committee and Promotion of Cromer will be sharing a stall on Lifeboat Day.
- **8.6 NNDC Tourism:-** The Clerk reported that Michelle Burdett from North Norfolk District Council will be attending the next meeting.
- 8.7 Town Crier:- Jason reported that he attended the Armed Forces Day and was on the Pier to greet the two ladies who walked from Little Massingham to Cromer. This was a total of 52 miles and the ladies set out at 4.00 am and arrived at 8.30 pm on the pier. Jason has attended a competition in Tetbury and was officially placed 4th. Jason will be attending the Cromer Carnival again this year.

- 9.1 Promotion of Cromer:- The Chairman reported that the Norfolk Show went very well and the he would like the Promotions Committee to look at doing the Norfolk Show and other local events next year. In order to attend shows further afield a budget will need to be set to cover volunteers expenses and overnight accommodation. More volunteers are needed for next year. It was reported that the zip on the bag the gazebo came in is broken. It was AGREED that the Clerk would liaise with the company who produced the gazebo and negotiate a good price for the heavier duty bag bearing in mind that the gazebo is less than a year old. It was AGREED that the Clerk would also try and negotiate an extension strip for the gazebo.
- 9.2 Queen's Birthday Commemorative Plaque: The Clerk reported wording that needs to be used on any commemorative plaque. It was felt that the plaque should not be placed on the heritage lighting columns in the Churchyard and

the Clerk will check with the Parish Church whether it can be placed on one of the pillars at the front entrance.

The Clerk will also mention the cable ties that are left on the railway track following the removal of their banners.


Hi Janet.

Report to Cromer Town Council Promotions Committee

12th July 2016

May I, on behalf of the Cromer Twinning Committee, thank the Town Council for their generous contribution to the recent visit of our twin towns of Crest and Nidda, also our friends from Ponte San Nicolo in Italy.

The visit was very successful, although we learned several things which, should we do anything similar in the future, that we will bear in mind when considering a programme for the visitors.

I also wish to thank the Mayor Tim, Deputy Mayor John and other members for their help over the weekend, and that includes Clir Jen Hamilton Emery and her husband for hosting some French people.

We shall be holding an EGM later this month to discuss the way forward. Your committee is struggling with six members, most of whom have been on the committee for several years. The health and age of some of them is advancing, together with various health problems. This does not reduce their ambition for the idea of Town Twinning, but it does increase their physical inability to do what we did when we were younger.

As I say the reason is to examine where we go from here. We have been invited to Crest in early June 2017, together with Nidda and Ponte San Nicolo, also Dobra in Poland and Medvod in Slovenia. These towns are also twinned with Crest, and the visit has the potential of being a big event. The theme is Youth and their contribution to society, part of the European Union programme for twinned towns.

Our initial reaction is one of us participating with the event, and we shall endeavour to find a local youth group who would be willing to represent the youth of Cromer. In that regard we do need help with this and would dearly love the Town Council to assist us with that ambition. Whilst we acknowledge the contribution of Cllr Yiasimi on the committee, we are asking for more members to come and assist us on the committee. We would need to fund the transportation of the young people and possibly contribute to their accommodation in Crest. The total number of people invited from each town is 20, which I assume includes the young people.

So I invite members of this committee to come to the meeting on the 28^{th} of this month at the Community Hall and to take part in the discussions.
