IMPORTANT NOTICE

UNAUTHORISED ITEM ON GRAVES

Please note that in the New Year the Town Council will be removing unauthorised items on graves. These items will be stored securely for 8 months to allow time for the families concerned to make arrangements to collect them.

- Tributes must be restricted to the plinth of the headstone or if there is no headstone, to an area not exceeding 2'6 x 1" and in line with other headstones.
- In respect of the cremation plots, all flowers must be placed in inset vases. No other items are permitted.
- No vases are permitted in the Garden of Remembrance other than those which have been given permission by the Town Council.
- In respect of the baby grave section, tributes are permitted on the whole of the grave but are subject to the restrictions listed below.
- No breakables (eg. glass, china, pottery etc) are permitted anywhere in the cemetery.
- No items which emit light, sound or movement are permitted anywhere in the cemetery.

NOTE: Christmas wreaths are permitted on graves but they will be removed by the end of February or earlier if they become unsightly.
