

## **Fireworks, Cromer 01 January 2019**

### **Children's Art Competition**

On 01 January 2019 we will celebrate Cromer's 20<sup>th</sup> annual Firework Display which began in 2000. We are delighted to announce that in addition to the photography competition, Titanium Fireworks are sponsoring a children's art competition.

#### **Statement from Titanium Fireworks**

In 2019 Titanium Fireworks would like to support the Cromer NYD Fireworks Display by offering a prize for a drawing competition. This prize has been inspired by a local school girl, Maisy, who last year drew us a fantastic picture of the display.

Submission of entries must be with Cromer Town Council by 25th January 2019.

*Prize – We will invite the winner for a tour of the firing site prior to our show and the opportunity to lead the countdown and start the 2020 display.*

The prize will be anonymously judged by Titanium Fireworks. The type of picture is unrestricted and can be a drawing, painting, or any other appropriate medium. The child must be in Year 6 or under and the piece should be their own effort.

#### **Brief: Cromer's Fireworks 2019**

We are looking for drawings/paintings etc that really capture the spirit of the Fireworks in Cromer, so come along to Cromer on 01 January to watch the display and then go home and get creative.

The competition entry deadline is Midday on Friday 25 January 2019. The winner and his/her family will be invited to the Annual Town Meeting on 13 March 2019 at which the winner will be formally announced.

#### **Photography Competition rules**

1. The artwork must be the sole work of the named entrant.
2. All entries can be sent by email (only one scanned entry per email) or by hard copy. Entries must be accompanied by a signed entry form (refer below) and must arrive BEFORE midday on Friday 25 January 2019.
3. The artwork can be in any medium.
4. Entrants may enter no more than 3 different pieces of artwork.
5. Emails should be sent to [fireworks@cromer-tc.gov.uk](mailto:fireworks@cromer-tc.gov.uk) and postal copies to Firework Art Competition, c/o Cromer Town Council Offices, North Lodge, Overstrand Road, Cromer, Norfolk, NR27 0AH.
6. Each entry should include the entrant's name, address and phone number and be signed by a parent/carer. Personal details will be stored and used for the duration of the competition, for the awarding of the prizes and for photo credits.
7. Drawings/paintings must be no larger than A3.
8. Scanned entries submitted by email should be no larger than 3MB.
9. The competition is open to all children up to and including school year 6.
10. All commercial rights to the artwork remain with the artist with the following exception:
  - a. The New Year's Day Fireworks committee and Titanium Fireworks have the right to use all entries in any future publicity material (print or electronic inc. Social Media) without

payment – subject to crediting the original artist. This includes the right to grant use of the image by third parties solely for the purpose of promoting future events.

11. The competition will be judged by representatives from Titanium Fireworks. Winners will be notified by email or phone, the judges' decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into. Prizes are non-negotiable and non-transferable.
12. Judging will take place during February and winners and runners up invited to the Annual Town Meeting on 13 March 2019.
13. By entering the competition you agree to participate in any reasonable publicity which may be generated as a result of the competition.
