CEMETERY INSPECTION

Unauthorised items on graves

Please could all visitors to the cemetery be reminded of the rules and regulations relating to tributes on graves:

General Rules applying to the whole of the cemetery

Breakable items are not permitted - Breakable items are not permitted anywhere in the cemetery eg. Glass, ceramic, terracotta. The burial authority reserves the right to remove any items which, in the opinion of the burial authority, they present a safety risk (particularly if damaged).

Items which emit light, sound or movement - To retain the natural ambience of the cemetery, items which emit light or sound or movement are not permitted in any part of the cemetery eg. Windmills, balloons, windchimes, solar lights, candles.

Christmas Wreaths: Visitors are welcome to place wreaths on graves and cremation plots at Christmas provided these are removed by the end of February or earlier if they become unsightly. Any wreaths left on graves after this date will be removed.

An inspection of the cemetery is due to take place and any unauthorised items will be removed, labelled and stored securely for 8 months in order that the families concerned can make contact to arrange collection.
