1. **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

Cllr. Bartlett declared an interest in respect of Cromer Preservation Society.

2. **APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE**

Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr. Adams (work commitments)  
Cllr. Cox, Cllr. Hayman (holiday), Cllr Plewman (family illness and holiday).  
Members were reminded that they are summoned to meetings and are asked to  
provide reasons for absence.

Following discussion, it was **AGREED** to ask NNDC to supply polling cards for  
the forthcoming election (if contested).

4. **MAPPING OF CEMETERY BOUNDARY**

Concern raised by the Royal British Legion in respect of low branches  
overhanging graves has highlighted the need to formally establish the boundary  
line of the cemetery. An estimate has been received to have the land surveyed.  
Cllr. Harris advised that the quotation is very reasonable and suggested that the  
land is registered too. It was unanimously **AGREED** to proceed to have the land  
surveyed.

6. **NORTH LODGE PARK**

Cllr. Harris and Cllr. Airs presented a report which had been drawn up outlining  
the various options for running North Lodge Park. Following discussion it was  
unanimously **AGREED** to instruct the Clerk to work with Cllr. Airs and Cllr. Harris  
to prepare a business plan to include the costs involved for all the options which  
would involve the Town Council's involvement in running the park. It was further  
**AGREED** to contact NNDC to ask for their proposals for the future of North  
Lodge Park as it stands.
