**1. Apologies for Absence**

**2. Minutes of meeting held on 20 August 2018**

The minutes of the meeting held on 20 August 2018 were **APPROVED**.

**3. Restoration of War Memorial**

The Deputy Clerk will contact Cliveden for an update in respect of when the works will be complete.

**4. Unveiling and Re-dedication of War Memorial**

Re-dedication and unveiling - It was noted that the Committee Chairman, Clerk and Deputy Clerk have met with Rev. Jennie Hodgkinson to discuss the arrangements and draft the Orders of Service for the Armistice weekend. The Church are arranging the Service of Remembrance.

The service for the rededication of the war memorial will be held in Cromer Parish Church at 13:30 on Saturday 10 November 2018 and will be immediately followed by the official unveiling. Cllr. Pritchard advised that he still awaits a reply from Buckingham Palace. It was again suggested that Lord Townshend of Raynham Hall be contacted to ask whether a member of the Townshend family would be prepared to do the unveiling.

Falling Poppies Projection – This is still being researched to see whether it is feasible. It was noted that the Church have given consent.

'There but not There' project – It was noted that the silhouettes have been delivered and will be installed in the Church on Friday 09 November 2018.

**5. Battle's Over Commemoration – 11 November 2018**

The schedule for the day was noted. It was agreed to purchase 250 LED candles for the torchlight procession. These will be sold at £1.50 each. It was noted that the procession may have to go along New Street instead of the West Cliff footpath. Cllr. Adams is liaising with Highways who are drawing up a map for a rolling road closure for the weekend.
