

Fireworks, Cromer 01 January 2020 Photography Competition

On 01 January 2020 we will celebrate Cromer's 21st annual Firework Display which began in 2000. Now in its eighth year, this photography competition is open to all **amateur** photographers. We are delighted to announce that Titanium Fireworks are sponsoring the prize.

Prize sponsored by Titanium Fireworks

"In 2020 Titanium Fireworks would like to support the Cromer NYD Fireworks Display by offering a prize for a photography competition. The competition will be judged by a professional photographer, the firer of the show, and a manager of Titanium Fireworks.

Prize – We will provide backstage access to any of our shows throughout the following year to photograph the setup and shoot from a unique angle during the show of the winner's choice.

This competition is not open to professional photographers and no images taken may be used for financial gain of the winner. You may also not enter if you have previously won the competition.

It is understood that certain projects that we work on have restricted access and while we will make every effort to permit access for the winner the project management team (our end client) will have ultimate decision. Some elements of our setup at certain sites are commercially sensitive and as such we may ask that certain elements are not photographed".

Brief: Cromer's Fireworks 2020

We are looking for photographs that really capture the spirit of the Fireworks in Cromer, so come along to Cromer on 01 January, bring your camera, photograph the event and get creative.

The competition entry deadline is Midday on Friday 29 January 2020. The winner will be invited to the Annual Town Meeting on 18 March 2020 at which the winner will be publicly announced.

Photography Competition rules

1. Photographs must be taken in Cromer on 01 January 2020 and must be original and taken by you. It is the photographer's responsibility to obtain the appropriate permissions. By entering the competition you are agreeing to have the appropriate permissions.
2. All photographs can be sent by email (only one photograph per email) or by hard copy and be accompanied by a signed entry form (refer below) and must arrive BEFORE midday on Friday 29 January 2020.
3. Photographs may be in colour or black & white.
4. Entrants may enter no more than 3 different photographs.
5. Emails should be sent to fireworks@cromer-tc.gov.uk and postal copies to Firework Photography Competition, c/o Cromer Town Council Offices, North Lodge, Overstrand Road, Cromer, Norfolk, NR27 0AH.
6. Each entry should include the photographers name, address and phone number. (In the email accompanying electronic submissions and on the back of hard copy submissions). Personal details will be stored and used for the duration of the competition, for the awarding of the prizes and for photo credits.
7. Photographs must be in JPEG format for electronic submissions or at size 7x5 or larger for hard copy submissions.
8. Photographs submitted by email should be no larger than 3MB and should not be edited.
9. Photographs submitted by email should contain no watermark or other identifying mark.
10. The competition is open to all amateur photographers.
11. All commercial rights to the images remain with the photographers with the following exception:

- a. The New Year's Day Fireworks committee and Titanium Fireworks have the right to use all entries in any future publicity material (print or electronic inc. Social Media) without payment – subject to crediting the original photographer. This includes the right to grant use of the image by third parties solely for the purpose of promoting future events.
12. The competition will be judged by a professional photographer, the firer of the show, and a manager of Titanium Fireworks.
13. Winners will be notified by email or phone, the judges' decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into. Prizes are non-negotiable and non-transferable.
14. Judging will take place during February and winners and runners up invited to the Annual Town Meeting on 18 March 2020.
15. By entering the competition you agree to participate in any reasonable publicity which may be generated as a result of the competition.
