Deputy Mayor Walking from Land's End to John O Groats.

Rev'd Dr Mike Bossingham, the Deputy Mayor of Cromer, is doing a virtual walk from Land's End to John O Groats during 2021 to raise funds for Cromer Skate Park. The Skate Park is an independent charity that needs to raise £1,000 a year and is run by a team of volunteers. Last year was a difficult year for all charities and the Skate Park is no exception and has seen its reserves dwindle.

Mike, the treasurer of the Skate Park, has accepted the #Walk1000Miles challenge to walk a route of 1,000 miles from Land's End to John O Groats . All the walking is done locally and recorded on his mobile phone which is then transferred automatically to the #Walk1000Miles website which then tracks his progress on the virtual walk. He has already completed just over 170 miles and is now, virtually, between Sidmouth in Devon and Lyme Regis in Dorset. Much of this daily mileage is covered by Mike delivering prescriptions to folk around Cromer. You may have seen Mike doing this with his orange and blue duffle bag.

Mike says, "I have completed the #Walk1000Miles for the last 3 years and so this year I thought I would use the walking to help the Skate Park. I have never skated myself, but I am pleased to support this facility which is well used by young people."
