5. **VE DAY, VJ DAY. BATTLE OF BRITAIN & QUEEN'S JUBILEE
COMMEMORATIONS**

The Clerk presented a draft outline schedule of events which were agreed in principle.

It was noted that Thurs 02 June 2022 would focus on a street party in Church Street to commemorate the Queen's Jubilee and to give thanks to all the volunteers, businesses and organisations involved in the local effort during the Covid pandemic. Friday 03 June 2022 will involve events to dedicate and officially unveil the poppy panels near the War Memorial. The main focus of Sat 04 June 2022 will be an afternoon tea party and entertainment for the residents of Halsey House and any other parishioners who served in the war. On Sunday 05 June 2022 a service will be held in the Church possibly followed by an event in the marquee in North Lodge Park.
